ABSTRACT

This paper deals with the functions and importance of PLSS (Panchyat Lok Shiksha Samiti) and VLSS (Village Lok Shiksha Samiti) set up by the Government of India for improving school level Education system.

Introduction:

It is a medium through which society transmits its heritage of past experience and modifications, systems of values and the mode or skills. In ancient time, education was almost teacher centred.
